EVENT REGULATIONS

EOL competition rules apply in the stages of a series competition, except in the competition starts with WRE status, where IOF competition rules apply in the main classes. Each stage is carried out in accordance with the stage instructions.

PRIZE GIVING

Fellowships for the top three of the MN21 competition classes in the general accounting of the Cup. Cup and souvenirs for the top three in all classes.

M21 I place - EUR 500

M21 II place - EUR 300

M21 III place - EUR 200

N21 I place - EUR 500

N21 II place - EUR 300

N21 III place - EUR 200

POINT SYSTEM

All the points in the three races are used to calculate summary. In the event of points being equal in the top three, the number of higher places in the last competition will be decisive. If the place of the last competition is equal, the ranking of the contestants in the competitions in which both contestants participated shall be taken into account. If all of the above does not explain the rankings, then in the general calculation, the contestant who starts last in the last race will get a better place.

Points for each competition are awarded respectively: 1st - 100p; 2nd - 80p; 3rd - 70p; 4th - 62p; 5th - 55p; 6th - 50p; 7th - 46p; 8th - 42p; 9th - 39p; 10th - 36p; 11th - 33p; 12th - 30p; 13th - 27p; 14th - 24p; 15th - 22p; 16th - 20p; 17th - 18p; 18th - 16p; 19th - 14p; 20th - 12p; 21st - 10p; 22nd - 9p; 23rd - 8p; 24th - 7p; 25th - 6p; 26th - 5p; 27th - 4p; 28th - 3p; 29th - 2p; 30th - 1p.

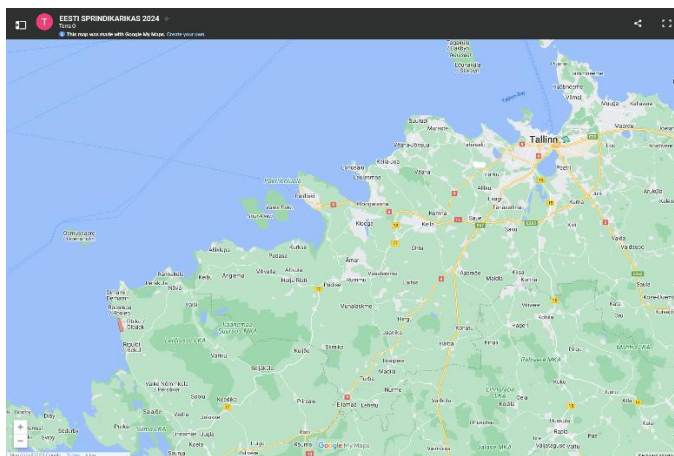
A competitor is not able to get a result in several competition classes in the same competition. If a competitor runs in a class that has the same track as another Sprint Cup class, he or she will still only get the result in his or her own class.

PARTICIPATION IN SPRINT CUP

Each competition is a separate competition with its own self-contained guide. Participating in competitions shall be conducted in accordance with the rules of the competition. No separate registration is required for participation in the Cup and entry into the consolidated accounts. Registration for each competition shall take place in the manner and within the time limits specified in its instructions.
